- 1. <u>Cement Repairs</u>: The crew removed and replaced the Handicap ramps on the corners of Tain & Dodford and Tain & Wensley. We also replaced two cracked and sinking flags on Wensley by the pool. The last location was on Melbourne by the park fence.
- 2. <u>Street Lights</u>: The crew removed and replaced the light pole at the corner of Clent and Carlton. The pole was rotted at the base and in danger of falling. The light fixture was replaced with a retrofitted fixture with a LED bulb. Upon completion, the street sign was rebanded and installed on the pole.
- **3.** <u>Sprinkler Systems</u>: All sprinkler systems throughout the village have been turned on and tested. Repairs were performed as needed.
- **4.** <u>Fence</u>: The fence around the park in Melbourne was repaired. We replaced five (5) 6x6 posts and thirty-two (32) fence slats which were rotted or broken. The gate at the entrance to Vivian lane was also rebuilt and replaced due to rottage. The fence is being power washed and will be painted.
